# MUNICIPAL AFFAIRS STATUTES AMENDMENT ACT (BILL 20)

Trustees reviewed the potential impact of Bill 20, intended by the United Conservative Party government to strengthen local elections and councils, on school trustee elections.

The Act will be debated soon in the Legislature and is scheduled to come into effect October 31. Upon the Act being proclaimed by the Government, the Board will follow up at a future meeting to discuss the need for new Board Bylaws relating to the potential (cont.) requirement for school board trustee candidates to submit a criminal record check and/or a deposit with their nomination papers in future elections.

Mentorship allows for growth, collaboration and life long learning so that every student can succeed.






### ANNUAL BOARD OF TRUSTEES HOLIDAY CARD ART CONTEST
