ITEMS FOR INFORMATION

THE EDUCATION AMENDMENT ACT (BILL 27)

Bill 27 passed in the legislature and received Royal Assent on December 5. The bill makes several amendments to the *Education Act* including sections involving gender identity, sexual orientation and human sexuality, as well as amendments to ensure education continuity during public health and states of emergencies. The Minister of Education recently announced the timelines for implementation, as follows:

Coming into effect in early 2025, upon proclamation:

- Notification for consent for health procedures
- Students' right to education
- Updated requirements for shifts to at-home learning

Expected to come into effect September 1, 2025:

- Notification and consent for preferred names and pronouns
- Parental opt-in for content on human sexuality, gender identity or sexual orientation
- Alberta Education approval of learning resources that deal explicitly with human sexuality, gender identity or human sexuality
- Updated polices related to at-home learning

Appreciation is extended to Terry Gunderson, consultant for the Alberta School Boards Association, who has provided resources to Alberta school divisions to support implementation of the different parts of Bill 27 identified above.

PARENT AND COMMUNITY ENGAGEMENTS

Two parent/community engagements were distributed in late December, with a mid-January end date, to learn more about parent/community interest in potential programming opportunities. One survey was distributed to Parkside Montessori parents to explore their interest re: expanding Montessori programming to grade 8. The second survey was distributed to the local Islamic community to learn more about interest levels for the potential development of a fee-based Islamic language instruction and/or a fee-based Islamic program of choice. Administration will report back on the information learned from the survey results upon completion of the review of survey data.

ALL ADMINISTRATION PROFESSIONAL LEARNING and PRINCIPALS MEETING

The December and January professional learning-focused meetings for all administrators and the principals' meetings occurred on Wednesday, December 11 and Wednesday, January 8. The professional learning sessions continued to focus on developing a shared understanding of the



alignment of structures and processes for all school and system leaders in the division. Additional time was provided for school leadership teams to work together with colleagues regarding the use of the Optimum Learning Framework to support the attainment of the priorities in each school's 3-Year Education Plan.

GPPSD LEADERSHIP ACADEMY SESSION 2

The second session of the division's Leadership Academy occurred on Thursday, December 12. The focus of the session was on the development of participants' knowledge of the characteristics of an adaptive school/school system and how leading an adaptive system can support student learning. Explicit focus was made on competencies from the Leadership Quality Standard related to being an instructional leader and helping participants to visualize how they and their role may change as they move from teacher to leader.

ALBERTA EDUCATION CAREER EDUCATION AND CURRICULUM ENGAGEMENT KICK OFF

The Deputy Minister of Alberta Education and curriculum staff hosted an update on new curriculum development implementation on Wednesday, December 18. The brief session reviewed the plans for grade 7-9 curriculum engagements that begin upon return from the Christmas break to support the development of next round of updated curriculum. Included in the next round of curriculum development will be integrated career education and practical life skills outcomes and the following explicit subject development:

- Grades 7-9 mathematics
- Grades 7-9 social studies
- Grades 7-10 physical education and wellness
- Career and Life Management (CALM)

Over 400 Alberta teachers, including several from the division, have volunteered to participate in the curriculum development process, and those selected will be announced shortly. More information will be shared as it becomes available.

RECORDS MANAGEMENT PLANNING

On Thursday, December 18, the Directors of Human Resources, Information Technology, and the senior leadership team met for an initial meeting to review the division's practices with respect to records management and records retention. Over the last several years the division has transferred to a number of paperless systems, including student registration, student records management, and human resources records management, to improve the accuracy and effectiveness of practices in business services. It is important to review division practices to ensure their alignment with legislative and legal expectations and to continually assess the effectiveness of our practices.

A more comprehensive review of division practices in all other areas of operation in the division, including those related to corporate governance and the handling and maintenance of Board records, is being considered for some point in the short- to medium-range future.

ARTIFICIAL INTELLIGENCE (AI) TO SUPPORT EVIDENCE-BASED PLANNING

I participated in a webinar on Thursday, December 19, focused on the role of generative artificial intelligence tools to support evidence-based decision-making processes in organizations. As the rapid pace of development of AI tools to support teaching, learning, and business operations continues, it is

important to develop deep understanding of not just the benefits of the use of artificial intelligence, but also the risks associated with it.

Much of the initial focus on AI during the last 12-18 months has been on the development of policies and guidelines for its use, and on the use of AI tools to support teaching and learning. The use of artificial intelligence to support business and operational processes has significant potential as well, but similarly needs to be understood well before strategic implication. Related to risks related to inappropriate access of data and the potential violation of privacy are risks related to cybersecurity and the security of operational processes.
